DAY 1 ARRIVE BROOME

Go off the beaten track by luxury 4WD vehicle, seaplane and fast boat. Experience the incredible Horizontal Falls and spectacular islands of the Buccaneer Archipelago plus explore new overland frontiers. Enjoy a rare opportunity to visit the world-renowned wilderness camp, 'Kooljaman' at Cape Leveque. The camp is owned and run by the Indigenous Bardi Jawi Communities and is famous for its astonishing diversity, pristine wilderness and unique landscape. Only a lucky few ever get to see this. You'll then visit the Aquaculture Hatchery at One Arm Point for a fascinating tour. (L)

DAY 3 LEISURE DAY

Today is free for you to explore Broome – we recommend taking an iconic sunset camel ride along Cable Beach.

DAY 4 LEISURE DAY

Spend the day exploring everything Broome has to offer. You might like to visit the historic Chinatown area overlooking Roebuck Bay, or perhaps go shopping for pearls. Broome is home to the finest pearls in the world – the South Sea Pearl – and there are plenty of options available if you'd like to learn more or even visit a pearl farm.

DAY 5 BROOME TO PERTH

This morning your adventure continues with a flight to the Western Australian capital, Perth. Here you have the afternoon free to enjoy this cosmopolitan city.

DAY 6 ROTTNEST ISLAND

Make your way to Barrack Street Jetty a short stroll from your hotel and board the Rottnest Express to unique, diverse Rottnest Island, 22km offshore. A 90-minute air-conditioned coach tour around 'Rotto' takes you to some spectacular locations, including Wadjemup Lighthouse and the boardwalk lookout at the rugged West End. Enjoy a delicious lunch before exploring the island at your leisure (make sure you see a quokka). Return to Perth by ferry in the afternoon. (B,L)

DAY 7 BOARD THE INDIAN PACIFIC IN PERTH

This morning join the Indian Pacific and, before long, you'll be heading through the delightful Avon Valley. Take time out to enjoy this iconic train and its many creature comforts. Enjoy a pre-dinner drink in the Outback Explorer Lounge with fellow travellers in anticipation of your late-night arrival into the gold-mining township of Kalgoorlie where you'll enjoy an Off Train Excursion.

DAY 8 INDIAN PACIFIC, NULLARBOR PLAIN

Wake to a spectacular Nullarbor sunrise. Relax throughout the day taking in the outback vistas before visiting the extraordinary and slightly eerie ghost town of Cook, home to a thriving population of four. (B,L,D)

As the landscape changes again and rich ochre sands make way for forests and farmlands, you will arrive into Adelaide in the morning and the culmination of your epic transcontinental crossing.
