After becoming acquainted with the sultry subtropical capital, delve deeper with a day spent at your leisure. (B)


DAY 4 – BOARD THE GREAT SOUTHERN IN BRISBANE

Whether you prefer red or white, there will be something to tantalise and delight, with tastings at three wineries throughout the day, and a delicious lunch with an accompanying glass of wine included in your tour. Today is yours to explore Adelaide and its surrounds at your leisure. The elegant capital's wine culture is matched by a buzzing food scene – find the best in its laneway bars and restaurants, or perhaps explore it's cultural, artistic, or retail side – the choice is yours. (B)
